

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF THE CITY CLERK FOR THE CITY OF BRANSON, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Section 79.320 of the Missouri Revised Statutes provides that the board of aldermen of a city of the fourth class shall elect a clerk for such board, to be known as "the city clerk"; and

WHEREAS, Section 79.320 of the Missouri Revised Statutes provides that the duties and term of office shall be fixed by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Branson Board of Aldermen deem this to be in the best interest of its citizens and visitors.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRANSON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The city clerk of the City of Branson, Missouri shall be elected by the Board of Aldermen for a continuous term from the date of election until removed from office by the City Administrator with the approval of the Board of Aldermen as set forth in the City Code.

Section 2: In pursuance of the Missouri Revised Statutes and the Ordinance made and approved by this Board, the Branson Board of Aldermen hereby elect Lisa K. Westfall to the office of "city clerk" and she is hereby authorized to discharge the duties of said office according to law; and to hold said office with the powers, rights and privileges empowered to her as set forth in the City Code.


Section 3: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
