Proposed changes to the ordinance are as follows:

- Better definitions for Managing Officer and Employees.
- Delete the two 3.2% Non-intoxicating Beer License types.
- Clarify the number of package liquor license holders in retail establishments with under 20,000 square feet of floor space and the number of license holders with over 20,000 square feet of store space.
- Change several of the liquor license types to reference definitions in the definitions section such as having 6-day beer and wine license type being issued only to Restaurant-bars and Resorts. Also there is a proposed change to set a minimum annual sales level for package liquor stores at \$5,000.00
- Establish a requirement for liquor training participation by servers and cashiers every three years.

Steve Scherer moved to approve the proposed changes to be placed before the Board of Aldermen, seconded by Sandra Williams. Voting aye: Raeanne Presley, Sandra Williams, Chris Vinton and Steve Scherer. Nays: none. Absent: Chris Lucchi. Motion carried.
