AGENDA

Discussion of revisions to the proposed Liquor Ordinances including overlay zones for package liquor licenses, server training, and hours for allowing those under 21 years of age to be in a restaurant/bar without a parent or guardian.

Also discussed were changes regarding boat licenses and the appeals process to the Board of Aldermen and the implementation of the new ordinances, including issues of budget, staffing and software.

Jack Purvis moved to recommend the revised ordinances to the Board of Aldermen, seconded by Chris Vinton. Chris Lucchi expressed concern over approving the ordinances without adequate time to study them fully in their final form. The committee agreed to meet the next week to approve the revised ordinances. Chris Vinton withdrew his second and Jack Purvis withdrew his motion.
