City clerk earns certifications



Branson City Clerk Lisa Westfall (left) received two certifications Monday night from Brenda Cirtin, Springfield, MO city clerk and chairperson of the Public Relations Committee of the Missouri City Clerks and Finance Officers Association. One of the plaques names Westfall a Missouri Registered Clerk by the Missouri City Clerks and Finance Officers Association, and the other plaque names her a Certified Municipal Clerk from the International Institute of Municipal Clerks.

These certifications require 100 hours of institute training over a period of four years. Westfall has been Branson's city clerk since February 2005. She also serves as Municipal Court administrator. Hired by the city in 1989, Westfall has held the positions of court clerk and deputy city clerk.

In 1993 she became a Certified Court Administrator and in 1997 was elected president of the Missouri Association for Court Administration.
